- Must be able to attend a briefing/induction session before the festival (Dates TBC)
- Fluent in English
- Drivers licence a plus but not required
- Pay a deposit of the full price of a Weekend Ticket to secure your volunteer place (refunded upon completion of volunteering duties)

Volunteer Roles

Site Set up/Breaking down

Work on the site begins on Thursday morning and includes setting up rubbish sites, art areas, setting out tables, chairs, signs, banners and other decoration. On Monday we do the reverse of Friday and return the venue to normal. Hopefully in a cleaner and greener state than we arrived.

Event Registration & Information

The Registration/information stand is the point of contact for the public when arriving and during the festival duration. We'll make sure you have the answers to as many of the questions people might ask you.

Camping ground Area/Traffic Management

We allow vehicles on site for artists and attendees to drop off equipment, however the parking area is just outside of the main lane. We also have an area for Caravans, so traffic needs to be managed for the safety of all in attendance.

Main Gate/Traffic Management

The Main entrance needs to be staffed throughout the weekend, the event is a ticketed event so we need to welcome people and advise them of the main area for registration and parking. We also need to check people have the relevant passes and manage the traffic on the lane driving to the main festival area.

Back Yard Area Volunteer

Volunteers would help set up stalls, help rearrange the areas for the needs of workshops and answer visitor questions about the area. Help with Bins & Litter in the area. Also able to walk around, provide help and advice. A high-vis jacket and Festival Tshirt let's people know who you are. If you can't help or answer the question, we'll make sure you know who can.

Car Park Attendants

Volunteers will provide a warm and cheerful welcome to all our visitors. Assist in directing visitor's cars and incoming/exiting traffic to ensure efficient parking, space availability and visitor safety due to moving traffic.

Anything else...

We may need you to help with sundry tasks that may crop up. Previous years we have needed people to help on stalls, act as stagehands, play sports, support vendors, clear out spaces, etc.

All these roles will suit people who... have an enthusiastic and friendly manner, enjoy meeting people and like working as part of a team, plus people who possess good customer service/communication skills, cash handling experience and who don't mind being outdoors.
