Apple - Emergency Fixes for Under-Attack iOS Zero-Day

THREAT

Apple on Tuesday dropped emergency security patches for its flagship iOS and iPad OS platforms alongside a warning that hackers may already be exploiting three different security vulnerabilities.

The patches -- contained in iOS 14.4 and iPadOS 14.4 -- are currently being pushed to mobile users via the automatic updating mechanism.

The vulnerabilities can be tracked as:

CVE-2021-1782, CVE-2021-1871 and CVE-2021-1870

ADVICE

The NCSC generally recommends following vendor best practice advice in the mitigation of vulnerabilities.

For all your IT equipment (so tablets, smartphones, laptops and PCs), make sure that the software and firmware is always kept up to date with the latest versions from software developers, hardware suppliers and vendors.
